



## EDP informs about PPA secured for a 150 MWac solar project in US

**Lisbon, January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026:** EDP, S.A. (“EDP”), through its 71.3% owned subsidiary EDP Renováveis, S.A. (“EDPR”), has secured a 30-year Power Purchase Agreement (“PPA”) with Consumers Energy Company (CeC) for the clean energy generated by a 150 MWac (209 MWdc) solar project in Clark County, Illinois, US.

The project is scheduled to begin operations in 2027, reinforcing EDP’s strategic positioning in North America as a key renewable energy player. It builds on EDP’s 3.4 GW solar portfolio currently in operation or under construction across US, showcasing the strength of its pipeline and its ability to forge long-term partnerships with major utilities.

This agreement further consolidates EDP’s low-risk growth strategy by developing projects with long-term visibility, delivering competitive, reliable, and clean power generation solutions.

Completion of this agreement is subject to the regulatory approval from the Michigan Public Service Commission.
