**Lisbon, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2026:** EDP, S.A. (“EDP”), through its 71.3% owned subsidiary EDP Renováveis, S.A. (“EDPR”), has secured a long-term offtake agreement with a global technology company for the clean energy generated by a 250 MWac (348 MWdc) solar project in Arkansas, US.
