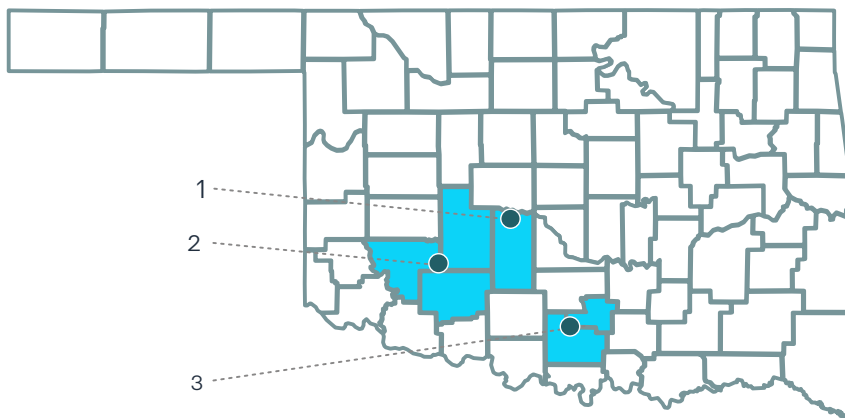


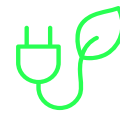


OKLAHOMA
